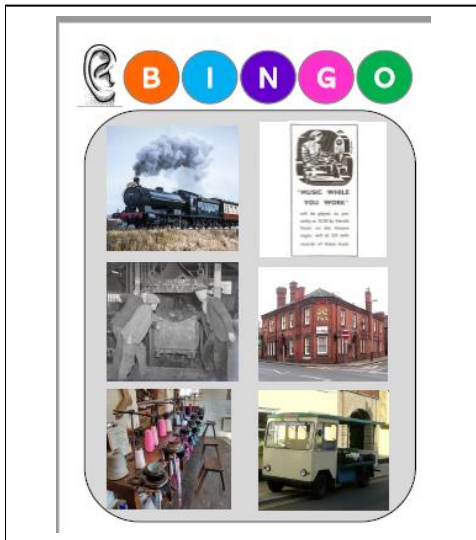


Working Life: Sound Bingo

Activity Information Sheet:



Activity:

Matching sounds and pictures

Duration:

10-30 minutes

Resources:

16 sound clips (6 sound effects and 10 spoken descriptions of working life); PDF of 6 bingo cards to print (1 has pictures to match purely the sound effects, 1 has pictures to match with all spoken descriptions, 4 are a mixture of sound effects and spoken words).

Extras:

Counters or bottle tops to place on the printed pictures. Alternatively, use the 'Fill and Sign' ✓ function in the PDF viewer.

Activity aim:

- To listen to people talking about their working lives and hear some familiar sounds of transport related to work. To match up photos and talk about paid and unpaid jobs that people did or wanted to do.

Instructions:

- As a one-to-one activity, choose 1 or 2 bingo cards and talk about the pictures.
- Play a random selection of sound clips and place a counter on each of the pictures which match with story or sound. One of the cards is purely sound effects (police car, steam train, tram, lorry, milk float, horse and cart).
- As a group (up to 6 people), take 1 card each and see who completes all 6 picture matches first.

Topics for discussion:

- What was your favourite job? Is there something you always wanted to do?
- Memories of tradespeople. Who came to your door and what did they sell?
- How do you think workplaces are different now to how they used to be?
