Activity:

A selection of Christmas day memories

Duration:

10 minutes

Resources:

1 sound clip which can be paused and replayed to clarify and discuss what has been heard.

A printable PDF of photos to talk about, if further prompts are required.

Extras:

Notebook or recording device to share stories about Christmas day traditions. Make a party hat out of newspaper!

Activity aim:

- To listen to a variety of sound recordings of people talking about Christmas day entertainment, interspersed with associated sound effects (approximately 5 mins in total).
- To recall stories about festive traditions including festive sounds and music.

Instructions:

- 1. Be still and quiet for a minute and listen to the sounds around you.
- 2. Explain that you are going to listen to people talking about what they did on Christmas day.
- 3. Look at the pictures of things you might hear and discuss them.
- 4. Play the sound clip, pausing and replaying as appropriate. Each of the spoken recordings are separated by a sound clip which could be a good place to pause. The clip includes: the National Anthem; listening to the King's speech (spoken); National Anthem; parties at home (spoken); bottles clanking; Uncle Will and his piano (spoken); Any Old Iron; a trip to the pantomime (spoken); laughter and applause.

Topics for discussion:

- Do these Christmas memories sound familiar to you?
- What do you think of the Royal family?
- Have you ever been to a pantomime? What do you like best about the theatre?
- What is your 'party piece'? How do you like to entertain people?
