Activity:

A soundscape to listen to

Duration:

5 minutes

Resources:

1 sound clip which can be paused and replayed to clarify and discuss what has been heard.

A printable PDF of photos to talk about, if further prompts are required.

Extras:

Notebook or recording device to share stories about farms and animals.

Activity aim:

- To listen to a variety of sound clips which have been recorded on a farm.
- To recall stories about living on, working on and visiting farms. Also, about caring for animals and being outdoors.

Instructions:

- 1. Be still and quiet for a minute and listen to the sounds around you.
- 2. Explain that you are going to listen to some farmyard sounds (cow, pig, dog, tractor, sheep, cockerel).
- 3. Look at the pictures of things you might hear and discuss them. What sound do they make? Have some fun imitating animal noises!
- 4. Play the sound clip, pausing and replaying as appropriate. See if you can identify any of the sounds by raising a hand or waving when you hear them on the recording.

Topics for discussion:

- Do you have a favourite farm animal?
- Have you ever worked on or visited a farm?
- What's the best job / worst job on a farm?
- How would you describe the smell of a farmyard?
- What might you use manure for in the garden?
