Activity:

Matching sounds and pictures

Duration:

10-30 minutes

Resources:

16 sound clips (10 sound effects and 6 spoken descriptions of toys); PDF of 6 bingo cards to print (1 has pictures to match purely the sound effects, 1 has pictures to match with all spoken descriptions, 4 are a mixture of sound effects and spoken words).

Extras:

Counters or bottle tops to place on the printed pictures. Alternatively, use the 'Fill and Sign' ✓ function in the PDF viewer.

Activity aim:

 To listen to people talking about their kitchens and hear some familiar sounds in a kitchen today. To match up photos and talk about kitchens and cooking then and now.

Instructions:

- 1. As a one-to-one activity, choose 1 or 2 bingo cards and talk about the pictures.
- 2. Play a random selection of sound clips and place a counter on each of the pictures which match with story or sound. One of the cards is purely sound effects (a whistling kettle, frying bacon, microwave oven, saucepan lids, pouring water, lighting the gas with a match.)
- 3. As a group (up to 6 people), take 1 card each and see who completes all 6 picture matches first.

Topics for discussion:

- What are the 3 most useful things in a kitchen?
- What would you cook in an earthenware pot?
- What do you prefer to cook with? Gas? Electricity? Coal? Wood? Charcoal? Microwaves?
- What is your least favourite and favourite kitchen sound?
- Have you ever had a bath in the kitchen?
