Sounds and pictures about leisure activities

Duration:

20 minutes

Resources:

2 PowerPoint presentations which contain photos and sound clips (one with sound effects, the other with spoken words). There is an interactive wheel to spin to help you choose your leisure activity!

Extras:

Notebook or recording device to share stories about evenings in and evenings out.

Activity aim:

- To listen to a variety of sound clips and stories around a theme of leisure activities.
- To recall stories about the places people visited and what they enjoyed doing there.

Instructions:

1. Be still and quiet for a minute and listen to the sounds around you.
2. Open the PowerPoint presentation and introduce the photos. Sound effects: dominoes, snooker, cards and bingo. Sound Stories: Burlesque Club, Youth Institute, The Brass House Pub and watching TV.
3. Spin the wheel of fun and listen to the associated sound clips.
4. Talk about what people like to do for fun in their leisure time.

Topics for discussion:

- What is your perfect leisure activity?
- Do you like going out for the evening?
- Have you ever been part of a team? Have you ever won anything?
- Was there a time when you stayed out very late or went to a pub for a lock in?
- How have the things we do for fun, changed over the years?
