This guide aims to help you to compress the size of your photos, making your document file size smaller

# SELECT THE PHOTO

Select the photo you would like to compress within your document by left clicking on the photo



At the top of your document click on Picture Format tab. Then, looking towards the left, select the Compress Picture option

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## **S**CHANGES

The default photo resolution (how clear a photo is) is set to 220 pixels per inch (ppi). Under Resolution, select the resolution you want, then click OK.
