# Supporting L23 communication & helping the team






#### Awakening ticket ballot

Data being publicly visible & updated nightly allowed team to monitor progress towards KPIs and amend approach

#### Media coverage

Time saved as team could use this data when reporting to Council Meetings, rather than producing reports. Could also walk through live data rather than out of data information.



Visualising data live helped improve formal evaluation. Errors were found earlier, and could be addressed in near real-time, rather than six months down the line.


